**Subject: Request to Stop Violation of Sikh Code of Conduct Being done at few Mandirs in Delhi.**

Respected Sir,

It has been noticed by the Sikh Sangat of Delhi that Disrespect of Shree Guru Granth Sahib Ji is going on in many Mandirs and Deras in the State.

As per ordinance issued by the Supreme authority of Sikhs ie. Shree Akal Takht Sahib, "People of all faiths and Countries are welcomed and allowed to show their respect toward Guru Granth Sahib ji and attain Spiritual bliss & Peace in Gurudwara Sahib but "Parkash" of Guru Granth Sahibji can not be done in Mandirs. Parkash can only done at the places where Sikh code of Conduct is followed i.e. Gurudwara".

If we look in past whenever sentiments of Sikh were hurt by violating Sikh code of Coduct by others it resulted in incidents like Nirankari clash in year 1978 and recent Vienna Tragedy [2009].

Sikh Sangat across the world and in Delhi is very much hurt to know that there are many Mandirs and Deras in Delhi where this violation is going on and on the contrary Delhi Sikh Gurudwara Management Committee [DSGMC] is aiding such people to do this by providing Saroops of Shree Guru Granth Sahib to Mandirs like Nij Thaow in Rajinder Nagar to satisfy there Political needs.

Entire case is already been brought over into the knowledge of Jathedar Shree Akal Takht Sahib and President Shromani Gurudwara Prabhandak Committee [SGPC] Amritsar.

Any information required by you to take corrective action in this regard shall be provided with irrefutable documentary proofs
